We have found an error in the justified number for Rental Self-Storage fees in our Sample Resolution that we sent you to assist with the adoption of your new Level 1 Developer Fees. *If you did not use our Sample, then this would not apply to your District.*

On page 4, first paragraph of our Sample Resolution, we listed your Rental Self-Storage amount as \$0.20 per square foot. This should have changed with each District's justified new rate found in the Study. This was a clerical error that should not have been missed and we apologize for the inconvenience this has caused. Your new rate will be \$0.10 instead of \$0.20. This number is shown in Table 12 of your Study. It does not affect any part of your justification of the increased residential or commercial/industrial fees.

If you have already adopted a resolution with the \$.20 Rental Self-Storage rate in error you should re-adopt a corrected Resolution at your next Public Hearing and send your County Office of Education that resolution. If you are currently in the process, then please verify you are using the correct rate.

There is not a need for a new hearing. There were no errors in the Developer Fee Study that was prepared, made available to the public for comments and then approved. As the proper procedures were followed, all that needs to be done is to have the corrected resolution adopted at your next Public Hearing. The timeline for implementation of the new fee level is not impacted either.

I have attached a copy of a new Sample Resolution with the correct fee listed on Page 4. If you have not adopted the Resolution to increase the Level 1 Developer Fees, please use this Sample instead of the one I sent you previously.
