WHEREAS, in 1977, Assembly Bill 120 required all school districts and county school offices to form geographical regions of sufficient size and scope to provide for all special education services needs of children residing within the regional boundaries. These geographical regions are known as Special Education Local Plan Area ("SELPA"). The District has been a Single District SELPA in the Natomas Unified School District since July 1, 2019.

WHEREAS, the NATOMAS UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT ("District") does not meet size and scope requirements adopted by SBE in 1983 to become a single district SELPA without a waiver, the staff is requesting the Board of Trustees' approval to submit to the SBE a Specific Waiver Request renewal of the Size and Scope Requirements in Order for the Natomas Unified School District to continue to operate as a single District SELPA.

WHEREAS, the District published a notice of the public hearing on the Request for Waiver, which included the time, date, location, and subject of the public hearing in the District schools in an area accessible to the public, the District Office and the District website, on February 25, 2020, and held the required hearing at its meeting on March 11, 2020.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the public hearing is to seek input from the District's stakeholders and to grant the opportunity for discussion of the District's intent renew the NUSD general waiver of size and scope requirements to maintain a single district SELPA within the District.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustee's hereby adopts this resolution to approve the Natomas Unified School District waiver of the single District SELPA size and scope requirements, such that Natomas Unified School District may continue to operate as a single District SELPA as of July 1, 2020.
